- 3) Graph titles should be very descriptive. One way to ensure this is to title the graph using both the independent and dependent variables. For example, "The Effect of Drop Height on a Ball's Bounce Height".
- 4) Please proof-read your work.
- 5) Please use complete sentences and formal writing language.
- 6) Please assume that the person reviewing your results and writing has no background in the subject. Therefore, write with enough detail to support or refute your claim.
- 7) Speaking of claim, in the conclusion, please state the claim, then go on to support or refute it with evidence.
